# Citizens Police Academy

The protection of law and order is one of the most valuable gifts that a tribe can give its members. To serve and protect its people fair and level across the board without prejudice is a protection that can never be taken for granted.

The Citizen's Police Academy gives people within the Southern Ute Reservation a revealing look into what it takes to serve and protect. Classes cover jurisdiction, emergency dispatch, victim services, criminal investigations, patrol, detention, community services and many aspects that make up the services provided to the community.

Opportunities are given to experience the training, equipment, physical requirements, situations and experiences that police officers handle on a daily basis.

## The Academy

The classes cover ten weeks of instruction one night per week for three hours. There are an additional six optional classes taking place on Saturday mornings giving a student over 40 hours of instruction on law enforcement.

Classes are limited to any Southern Ute Tribal Members or Community members. Students must be age 18 or older with no felony convictions or arrests and misdemeanor domestic violence convictions. You must also fill out a background check. Good physical health will be necessary to complete some of the optional classes. A Certificate of Completion will be given at graduation upon fulfillment of all coursework.
