Description of Permit Revision

On May 1, 2014, the Southern Ute Indian Tribe Air Quality Program (AQP) received a minor permit revision request from Red Cedar Gathering Company (Red Cedar) for the Pump Canyon Compressor Station (Pump Canyon) requesting to replace an existing tri-ethylene glycol dehydration unit, unit X-301, rated for a maximum gas throughput of 25 million standard cubic feet per day (25 MMscf/day) with a new dehydration unit, unit X-303, also rated for a maximum gas throughput of 25 MMscf/day. This replacement is due to unit X-301 not being able to meet the dew point requirements for the station. The addition of unit X-303 will result in an increase in hazardous air pollutant emission (HAPs) at Pump Canyon that change the source's applicability to 40 CFR 63, Subpart HH. Pump Canyon was previously considered an area source of (HAPs) operating a large glycol dehydration unit under 40 CFR 63, Subpart HH. With the addition of X-303, Pump Canyon is now a major source of HAPs operating a large glycol dehydration unit under 40 CFR 63, Subpart HH. While the permit was open, AQP took the opportunity to revise other conditions in the permit to accurately reflect the applicable regulatory language.

Specifically, the following revisions have been made to this permit:

Section I.B. – Source Emission Points

- Revised Table 1 to reflect new dehydration unit (Unit X-303).

Section II. – Site Specific Requirements

- Reformatted Section II. to use the citation system used in current operating permits issued by the Tribe.

Section II.B – 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart HH

- Revised permit language to reflect the requirements for a large glycol dehydration unit at a major source of HAPs.

Section II.F. – 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart ZZZZ

- Revised Condition II.F.11.a. to streamline the Subpart ZZZZ semi-annual compliance reporting dates with the Title V operating permit semi-annual monitoring report dates.

Section IV. – Part 70 Administrative Requirements

- Removed Condition IV.O.5., because requirements already captured in Condition IV.O1.

AQP is making these revisions as a minor revision in accordance with Reservation Air Code 2-111(3). The permit will be reissued as permit number V-SUIT-0036-2014.01.
