

## Southern Ute Indian Tribe Crossing Permit Renewal Instructions



Pursuant to the Southern Ute Indian Tribe, any person or entity conducting commercial activities on the reservation is required to possess a crossing permit. It is <u>your responsibility</u> as a commercial company to have the <u>VALID documents</u>, i.e. a copy of the SUIT Crossing Permit and current employee/vehicle list in every vehicle which crosses the SUIT reservation.

## \*Please review the enclosed permit for accuracy & completeness.

- *I.* If the form is complete and correct, sign the permit and mail it back with your payment & your employee/ vehicle/ equipment list. You may also renew your permit in person.
  - **A.** Mailing address: Southern Ute Indian Tribe; Department of Natural Resources/Lands Division; P.O. Box 737; Ignacio, CO 81137.
  - **B.** In person: Tribal Annex Building at 116 Memorial Drive. Call (970) 563-0126 for directions if needed. <u>Office Hours</u>: 7:00am 6:00pm.
  - **C.** Cash, checks or money orders ONLY (<u>we do not accept credit cards</u>). Make checks payable to "Southern Ute Indian Tribe".
  - D. You must include a list of all <u>current</u> employees, vehicles & equipment for the 2018 permit using the following example:

## III. Permit Fees

- A. Annual Permit: \$500 per company
- B. Vehicle Decals: \$40 per vehicle.
