The Defendant was placed under the supervision of the Probation Department for a period of \_\_\_\_\_ days/months by order of the Southern Ute Indian Tribal Court on \_\_\_\_\_. Your term of supervision commences on \_\_\_\_\_ and expires on \_\_\_\_\_ unless shortened or extended by the court. The terms and conditions of the Defendant's supervision are as follows:

1. The Defendant shall not violate any tribal, municipal, state or federal laws while under the supervision of the Probation Department.
2. The Defendant shall abide by all orders of the Southern Ute Tribal Court, whether written or verbal.
3. The Defendant shall appear at all Court proceedings pertaining to this matter as required.
4. The Defendant shall not change his/her residential address without obtaining the permission of a probation officer.
5. The Defendant may travel within a hundred mile radius of his/her residence. Travel outside this radius is allowable with the prior approval of the Probation Department. You must submit a written travel request 48 hours prior to your departure.
6. The Defendant shall permit visits by probation officer at home or elsewhere as desired by the probation officer.
7. The Defendant shall report to the Probation Department as required and submit a written supervision report and provide any other requested information.
8. The Defendant shall obtain any evaluation(s) required by the court and follow the recommendation of said evaluation(s).
9. The Defendant shall provide breath and/or urine samples for testing at any time upon request by a probation officer, with or without advanced notice, and pay any and all fees and costs associated with such tests.
10. The Defendant shall notify the Probation Department within seventy-two (72) hours of any police contact.

11. The Defendant will maintain full time employment unless excused by the Probation Officer for schooling, training, or other acceptable reasons. The Defendant will immediately notify the probation officer of any job changes.
12. The Defendant shall not use any form of alcohol, including products such as cough syrup, mouthwash, etc., that have alcohol in them. The Defendant shall not remain in the company of persons who are intoxicated.
13. The Defendant shall not be in a bar or establishment whose primary business is the sale of alcohol.
14. The Defendant shall not use or possess illegal drugs. The Defendant must inform the Probation Department of all prescribed medications. The Defendant shall not remain in the company of persons who use or possess illegal drugs.

These Conditions of Supervision have been read by or to the Defendant. The Defendant represents by signing below that he/she understands the terms and conditions of supervision, the possible consequences of violating them and received a copy of them.
