

The Southern Ute Indian Tribal Council approved Resolution 2021-104, amending the adopted key metrics and restrictions for various phases of the COVID-19 pandemic. The graphic below explains the changes in restrictions.

**Effective August 9, 2021**

The Southern Ute Indian Tribe will move to Phase III "Protect Our Neighbor"

## What has changed with the amended restrictions?

### Older Restrictions

### New Amended Restrictions

**Restrictions in Phase II, Level 1**

Personal Gathering  
No greater than 30

<u>Indoor Capacity</u>	<u>Outdoor Capacity</u>
75% 175 Max	75% 200 Max

**Restrictions in Phase III**

Personal Gathering  
No greater than 125

<u>Indoor Capacity</u>	<u>Outdoor Capacity</u>
Up to 100% 500 Max	Up to 100% 500 Max


