


UNDERSTANDING THE SOUTHERN UTE INDIAN TRIBE AMBIENT AIR MONITORING WEBSITE

The Southern Ute Air Quality Division operates three Air Monitoring stations on the Reservation. The air quality data and corresponding EPA Air Quality Index values can be viewed in real time by visiting the website here: [Southern Ute Ambient Monitoring Website](#). The Tribe's three air monitoring stations continuously monitor and report on Oxides of Nitrogen (NO/NO₂/NO_x), Ozone (O₃), Particulate Matter (PM), Wind Speed, Wind Direction, Outdoor Temperature, Relative Humidity, Solar Radiation, Precipitation and Visibility.
